- Accent means prominence given to the syllable

Types of Stress

- Lexical Stress
 - · Break /brek/
- Prosodic Stress or Tonic Stress



Types of Accent

- 1. Primary accent: The syllable with both Lexical & Prosodic stress
- 2. Secondary accent: The syllable with only Lexical stress
